Club Information

The Northern Washington County Trail Blazers was established in 2004. It is a member of the Washington County Association of Snowmobile Clubs and the New York State Snowmobile Association. All members of the Northern Washington County Trail Blazers will also become members of the NYSSA.

The club was established to promote safe, courteous, wise and lawful use of snowmobiles for individual and family recreation.

- Snowmobiles using the trails must be registered and insured
- Youths 14-17 years old may operate a snowmobile without adult or other supervision if they have completed a snowmobile safety training course recognized by the State of New York. Youths 10-13 years old may operate a snowmobile, on lands upon which snowmobiling is allowed, if they have completed a snowmobile safety training course recognized by the State of New York and are accompanied by (within 500 feet of) a person who is at least 18 years of age. Children under age 10 or under age 14 without a safety certificate may operate a snowmobile only on lands owned or leased by their parent or guardian.
- The county trail system is patrolled by various law enforcement agencies

Having a trail system depends on hundreds of landowners giving permission to have a trail on their land. Each club member can help maintain a positive relationship with landowners by doing the following:

- Staying on trails
- Obeying trail signs
- Operating snowmobiles in a safe manner

Meetings are held at 7:00 PM on the third Thursday of the month at the Putnam Fire House on State Route 22 in Putnam Station, New York.
